6. Employ AI and technology tools.

3.*Punctuation* :Learn the proper use of punctuation marks ,such as commas ,periods ,question marks ,and exclamation points .Understand how punctuation affects the structure and meaning of a sentence .

4.*Sentence Structure* :Familiarize yourself with different sentence structures ,including simple ,compound ,and complex sentences .Understand how to combine clauses and phrases to convey meaning effectively .

5.*Modal Verbs* :Learn the functions and usage of modal verbs like “can” ,”could” ,”may” ,”might” ,”should” ,”must” ,etc .These verbs express possibility ,necessity ,permission ,and ability .

6.*Prepositions* :Understand how prepositions indicate relationships between words and phrases .Learn common prepositions and their usage in expressing time ,place ,direction , and other relationships .
