Interactive instruction aligns with Communicative Language Teaching, which prioritizes meaningful communication over mechanical practice. Task-based learning represents a particularly effective interactive approach, especially when supported by technology. According to Thomas and Reinders (2010), task-based language learning encourages learners to use language as a tool for

accomplishing meaningful goals rather than as an object of study. Technology-supported tasks create authentic, real-world scenarios that promote collaboration, negotiation of meaning, and learner autonomy.

Through such tasks, learners actively engage with language while solving problems, sharing ideas, and completing communicative objectives. The integration of technology further strengthens both interactive and visual methods. Visual input supports comprehension and retention, while interactive engagement encourages learners to actively use language in meaningful contexts. The role of task-based learning, especially when integrated with technology, is particularly noteworthy. As emphasized by Thomas and Reinders (2010), technology-supported tasks provide learners with authentic communicative situations that mirror real-life language use. This supports the view that language learning is most effective when learners are actively involved in achieving specific goals through language.
